## 2. New Features

- RecordChangeEvent Event has a new setting: Process changes separately: For each logged record a separate message will be created. Whereas before it would always use a recordset
- XMLPortXMLGenerator Activity has a new setting: Generate without filter: Enabling this setting will allow an xmlport to run without any filters. Disabled it will throw an error halting the message.
- These changes together supports a new scenario: the Record Change event followed by the XMLPortXMLGenerator. Before these changes, the only supported event was limited to a timerevent.
