#### 2.1 Version number update

Version numbers from To-Increase horizontals will no longer be aligned with the current version of Dynamics 365 Business Central, but will stay for now on 18.4

The goal is to align with the minimum required version of D365 Business Central, so that it's easy to determine if a release can be installed on a specific Business Central environment.

For now the minimum version of D365 Business Central will remain 18.0.

This method of versioning will be applied to our vertical solutions in due time.
